DECIDES

Article 2. Approving the collaboration in education with the following main contents:

1. Recruitment subjects:

- Vietnamese citizens who have graduated from high school or equivalent; and;
- Foreign citizens who have graduated from high school or equivalent.

2. Recruitment conditions

2.1 English Requirements

One of the following:

- Academic IELTS or UKVI IELTS 6.0 overall with no sub-skill below 5.5. We will accept IELTS Academic (other) or IELTS Indicator (online).
- IBT TOEFL (internet based or Special Home Edition), including MyBest Scores with 78 overall with a minimum score of 17 in writing, listening, 18 in reading and 20 in speaking.
- PTE Academic UKVI or PTE Academic with 56 overall and at least 51 in each sub-skill.
- Cambridge C1 Advanced English exam (CAE), 169 overall with a minimum of 162 in each sub-skill.

- Cambridge C2 Proficiency English exam (CPE), 180 overall with a minimum of 162 in each sub-skill.
- Pass BUV English for Academic Purposes 3 (EAP3) /UNIPATH3

2.2 Academic requirements

One of the following:

- Vietnamese or other countries' high school diploma or equivalent and completion with passing grade of the agreed Pathway to University programme.

Notes: BUV may self-assess whether the degree/certificate/other legal document is equivalent to Vietnamese Highschool Diploma and shall take responsibility for the assessment results. Where necessary, BUV may request degree/certificate/other legal document holders to apply for degree recognition in compliance with Vietnamese regulations.

- IB (International Baccalaureate) Diploma - 30 points
- Two Advanced Placement (AP) exam results with a grade of 3 or higher, accompanied by a US High School Graduation Certificate.
- BBB at GCE A-Level.
- Recognised Foundation Diploma, equivalent to L6 SCQF, at Pass
- T-level grade of Merit or above
- BTEC/OCR Extended Diploma at Distinction, Merit, Merit, BTEC Level 3 Diploma, DDM*
- Scottish Highers - ABBB - by the end of S5, AABB - by the end of S6
- Australian High school Diploma with ATAR score from 85
- A combination of BTEC Subsidiary Diploma and A-Levels - equivalent to 120 UCAS Tariff points
- Three BTEC Subsidiary Diploma passes at Grade Merit
- Pass 4 or more modules in International Foundation Programme of University of London

- New Zealand University Entrance Certificate with National Certificate in Educational Achievement Level 3
- Canadian high school diploma with an average of 75% in Grade 12 subjects
- Australian Year 12: average grades of at least 70%

Second route:

Students will be able to apply for admission to the University of Stirling Undergraduate programmes at BUUV upon meeting at least one of the following entry requirement options and successfully completing the appropriate agreed BUUV pathway programme:

- Existing Route: Application with the high school diploma (Bang tot nghiệp trung hoc pho thong) or equivalent.
- New Route: Application with the Certificate for completion of general education Grade 12 (Chứng nhận hoàn thành chương trình giáo dục phổ thông) or equivalent AND GPA of high school years over 5.0/10

3. Duration and training programme:

3-year training period. The programme is fully delivered in Vietnam with the programme contents provided by University of Stirling.

4. Teaching Language: English.

5. Lecturer team:

All the lecturers from British University Vietnam and University of Stirling, having professional qualifications and language met the requirements of the collaborative programme as well as the current regulations of both Vietnam and the UK.

6. Teaching location: British University Vietnam.

7. Degree Certificate: BSc (HONS) Software Engineering issued by University of Stirling.

8. Training cost and financial management: Training cost will be paid by learners in accordance with British University Vietnam's regulations. Tuition fee collection is published on the official website of British University Vietnam.

Article 3. Duration of the collaboration is 5 years from the date of this Decision.

Article 4. Relating schools and departments are responsible for annually reporting the collaboration implementation to the competent authorities in accordance with the current regulations.

Article 5. Dean, Registrar, Discipline leads, relating departments and individuals are responsible for implementing this Decision.
